THREE DAYS - INDIVIDUAL LESSON FORMAT

Learn Relational Horsemanship with Kylie in the winter clinic series! There will be three clinic days spread out over three months in an individual lesson format. Riders choose which days to participate in with their horse and are encouraged to audit the full clinic day to maximize their learning.

CLINIC OUTLINE

- Learn the foundations of Relational Horsemanship[™] both on the ground and riding.
- Learn horse and rider biomechanics that promote balance, soundness, and gaits that are smooth to ride.
- Deepen the bond with your horse and feel safer in new situations.
- Discover Free Liberty work and the power of becoming a partner your horse chooses to be with.
- Grow as a rider and a person so that you can lead with confidence and bring out the best in your horse.
- Develop elements such as shoulder-in and leg yield to increase flow and improve lead departures.

*Each clinic has a different dynamic of people and horses. Lessons prioritize meeting the horse's needs and may focus on elements not listed here. If one of these goals is important to you, please mention so at the beginning of the clinic.

PAYMENT & CANCELLATION POLICY

Remaining balances are due 30 days before the clinic. Balance payments are non-refundable and can only be applied to a credit for future clinics.

Cancellation: If you cancel out of the clinic at any time, the deposit and balance is forfeited. If we are able to fill your clinic spot with another rider, then both your deposit and balance can be applied to a future clinic if space permits.
